Transcribing Your Dictations

As soon as you send your dictations via the Fluency Mobile app, your dictations move into production.

Our experienced transcription team type your files, and return the completed files to your account.

Let us know which template/s you wish us to use. We will use your letterhead/report template/s to create a similar version in Fluency. Your completed files will be available to download in RTF or PDF format.

Rich Text Format (RTF) files are widely supported by several software applications and text editors, making them compatible with different platforms and operating systems.

Word processors are the most common applications used to open RTF files, as they allow users to create, edit and format documents while preserving the intended appearance.

Offering excellent compatibility, RTF files can be opened by most word processing programs including Microsoft Office (where you have the option to 'save as' .doc, .docx), Google Docs and Apple Pages.

** Important note for Apple Pages users: Apple Pages does not support .rtf images, so if your clinical letterhead includes images, you may need to open these files in another platform such as Microsoft Word.

*** Fluency Mobile app users are charged at the Standard Plus Service, Express Plus Service, or Platinum Plus Service rate, depending on how quickly you require your transcripts returned. Refer to the rates sheet for details.

Freedom.

Providers already carry a smartphone with them all the time. Why hunt for a free phone at the nurse's station? Sit quietly whenever you want, collect your thoughts, and dictate away. Interrupted? Pause your dictation, and resume at a later time.

If you are dictating in an area with poor mobile phone coverage, you can still dictate at any time. Your completed dictations will be stored in your outbox until you move into an area with better mobile coverage.

Three Top Dictating Tips

You don't need to spell medical, legal, or business terminology, sector-specific, or technical words.

Pacific Transcription engages transcriptionists who are highly experienced in all areas of medical, legal, and business dictation, so there is no need to spell out medical terminology, sector-specific, or technical words.

However, there are some types of words which do benefit from being spelled out, letter-by-letter. These include spelling out the names of unfamiliar landmarks, small townships, or remote areas, particularly those which are referred to by their local dialect name/s.

2 Know when to spell patient names.

It is beneficial to spell out patient names which may have an unusual or uncommon spelling, or multiple ways of spelling. To the transcriber Catherine, Kathryn, Katherine, Cathryn, Katharine, Katheryn, Kathrine, and Catharine will all sound the same.

Speak more slowly.

Pause before and after dictating, to avoid clipping information. A well-ordered thought most often translates into a well-ordered, concise, and considered dictation.

Take regular moments to compose your thoughts, and slow down your dictation speed.
